A Spartan apparatus subsidiary will complete the body and they will accelerate delivery of the truck as much as possible.

Marion is proud that we were able to contribute in the making of this new truck for New York. It is estimated that 65 pieces of emergency apparatus were lost in the New York tragedy.

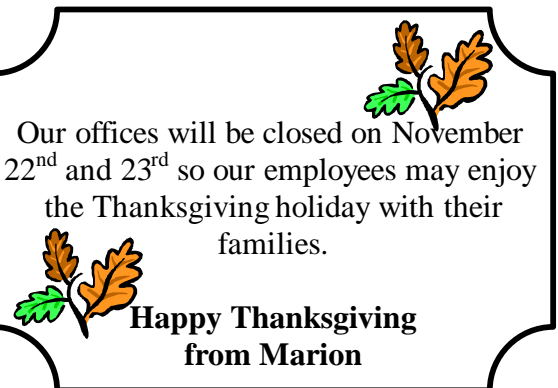
